Kindergarten Registration

Children must be 5 years old by September 1, 2021. Registration will take place on-line.

Please make certain you are on the screen for 21-22 if registering for the next school year.

Step 1: Register Online Here: https://www.hcpss.org/enroll/

It is recommended that you work on a laptop or desktop to complete registration. Cell phone registration is not recommended.

Step 2: Complete registration online by providing the documents listed below. The registration process is easier if you upload them during online registration. Otherwise, you will be asked to submit them via email as pdfs. Iphone users can scan documents through your notes app. (Images must be clear.)

The following documents are needed for registration:

- Child's evidence of birth and Parental Relationship (ie: birth certificate, baptismal certificate)
- An authorized record of immunizations
- Proof of residency in the form of a signed lease or deed including signature pages
- Current utility bill
- Photo ID of enrolling parent/guardian
- Proof of custody (if applicable)

Kindergarten End of Year Celebration June 11!



Will your student need a medication while at school for the 2021-22 school year? Any medication including prescription, over the counter, or herbal medications require an order from an approved health care provider (this includes epi pens, inhalers, etc). The medication from must be completed on or after July 1st 2021 to be valid. Feel free to contact the health room for questions.

What Do I Do With My Child's Chromebook at the End of the Year?

Only students leaving **HCPSS** after the current 2020-2021 school year, including those unenrolling or moving out of **Howard County**, must return their assigned HCPSS technology devices, including Chromebooks and the charging cord. Please return these items to your child's school or the Technology Center on or after your child's last day of school. Hot spots need to be returned only if the family does not have other children who will be enrolled for the 2021-2022 school year.

Students who will remain in HCPSS schools for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year may continue to borrow HCPSS technology devices over the summer. Families are encouraged to review the HCPSS Chromebook Care guidelines with their students to ensure that devices are taken care of. Families are fully responsible for maintaining their child's Chromebook and charger. If you have concerns about keeping your child's Chromebook safe and in working order over the summer, please return it to school. Your child will receive it back when they return in the fall.

Families returning HCPSS technology devices can log in to HCPSS Connect to ensure they are returning the correct device.

- 1. Log in to HCPSS Connect Synergy using parent/guardian credentials
- 2. Select More Options from the left navigation.
- 3. Select Student Technology from the list displayed in the center of the screen.
- 4. Compare the asset tag number that appears on a sticker on the device with the words "Property of HCPSS Inventory" to the one displayed on the Inventory List table.
 - 1. Check all devices in the household and ensure the correct devices are returned to the appropriate school locations.
 - 2. If the asset tag number listed in HCPSS Connect does not match any of the devices in the household, let staff know when the device is being returned so that the data can be updated appropriately and the device can be unassigned.

Families who are returning for the next school year but do not wish to keep their HCPSS technology devices over the summer may return them to their school or a <u>Technology</u> <u>Support Center</u>

Effective Monday, March 22nd, devices may be exchanged or returned at either of the following Technology Support Centers:

- Old Cedar Lane, Gym (door on the left side of the building; follow the signs), 5451 Beaverkill Road, Columbia (Building shares a parking lot with Harper's Choice MS)
- Old Bushy Park Elementary School, Room E2 (door to the left of the front entrance), 2690
 Route 97, Glenwood (Building is between Glenwood MS and Bushy Park ES)

Note! Both locations are in old school buildings that are not located at the same sites as the new schools with similar names. Anyone seeking assistance should go to the addresses listed above. **Hours of operation are M/W/F from 7:30 am - 12:30 pm and T/Th from 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm.** Technology Support Centers are closed any day that HCPSS offices are closed.
