SCHOOL TARGETS AND STRATEGIES

Language Arts

Target: Increase the number of students who score 4 or better on MCAP ELA assessment.

Strategies:

- Instructional staff will engage in professional learning on the learning progressions of the literacy standards. Staff will apply understanding to support effective differentiated small group instruction.
- Administrators will schedule structured time for teachers to review data and collaboratively plan. Teachers will engage in purposeful collaborative planning of differentiated small group lessons supported by the Literacy Coach.
- Teachers will engage in collaborative planning with ESOL staff to imbed best practices for our multilingual students.

Mathematics

Target: Increase the number of students who score 4 or better on MCAP Math assessment.

Strategies:

- Instructional staff will engage in professional learning on problem solving and perseverance.
- Collaborative planning features selecting high-quality tasks, anticipating student strategies, direct instruction, and prompting to support productive struggle.
- Instructional staff will engage in professional learning on best practices for teaching mathematics to multilingual students.

School Climate

Target: Decrease the number of office referrals and school suspensions.

Strategies:

- Staff will engage in focused trauma training in order to utilize strategies to create a trauma sensitive classroom and learn strategies to support all stakeholders experiencing secondary trauma within our school community.
- Students and staff will have opportunities to participate in decision making by revamping our PBIS expectations and strategies and implementing them with fidelity.
