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SCHOOL STRATEGIES, COMMITMENTS, & ACTION STEPS

Reading Commitment: We commit to implementing all components of literacy while ensuring maximum Tier 1 instruction, with Tier 2 or 3 support as needed.

Action Steps:

- -Use entrance and exit criteria to identify Tier 2 and Tier 3 supports
- -Include Multilingual Learner (ML) English language proficiency (ELP) levels, student backgrounds, and time in the ELD programming as part of data meetings, discussions, and instructional decision making
- -Provide ongoing communication with families via Canvas, Talking Points, phone calls, and in-person conferences to share student performance

<u>Math</u> Commitment: We commit to using effective assessments to provide meaningful feedback and targeted instruction that supports student mastery of standards.

Action Steps:

- -Review and use data to make instructional decisions to respond to student learning needs using an established data protocol
- -Provide professional learning about general and specific student feedback
- -Create anchor charts or visuals for success criteria making expectations visible and accessible during tasks, especially for our ML learners
- -Invite families to a "learning walk" or classroom showcase to strengthen the home/school connection and equip families to support learning at home

<u>Attendance</u> Commitment: We commit to fostering healthy relationships and a sense of belonging so students want to come to school.

Action Steps:

- -Monitor staff taking actions to cultivate belonging through observation
- -Solicit student feedback on how to make school more welcoming & engaging
- -Regular communication with families regarding attendance

Discipline Commitment:

Action Steps:

- -Designated staff will engage in the monthly discipline discussion
