

New Lunch Procedures

There are several updates related to cafeteria protocols to further reduce the risk of the spread of COVID-19.

- Plexiglass shields for indoor cafeteria tables are being secured for grades k-6 where students are largely unable to be vaccinated. These panels will provide additional protection between students who are unable to be vaccinated while eating when masks cannot be worn.
- All students will have an assigned seat for contact tracing purposes.
- Students must wear masks when not eating.
 - This includes:
 - Entering and exiting the cafeteria
 - Standing in the lunch line
 - Leaving their seats to throw away trash, going to the bathroom, getting a drink of water, etc.
 - Sitting at their table after finishing their meal
- All students will be encouraged to wash their hands and sanitize before and after lunch.
- The cafeteria has air conditioning and good air circulation with 30ft high ceilings.
- Outdoor seating will be available for students as weather and staffing permits. A tent will be provided for this area.
