# Canvas Calendar- seeing all the necessary courses

Click calendar on the left side bar

- On the right side of the screen you'll see your child's courses listed next to a gray or colored square (you change them by clicking on the square)
  - Gray means the course is not currently active on the calendar
  - Colored means the course is currently active on the calendar

All other courses need to be changed to gray


