Parents/guardians may make appointments at any of these locations; whichever is most convenient for them.

Multiple vaccines, many of which are required for school entry, will be offered. These vaccines will be provided at **no cost**. Upon registration, parents will be able to choose which vaccines their child needs.



Families can check md.myir.net to see which vaccines your child has already had, or contact your school nurse to determine what is needed.

Pre-registration online (due to Covid-19, we will be paperless at these clinics) is required; go to www.vaccineconsent.com

Registration is open from August 25–September 9.



Clinics will be held outdoors, and will utilize a virtual queue program so families can wait in their cars or away from the clinic. Families are encouraged to wear a face mask or other face covering.

Health Conditions and Medications

- If your child has a health condition that requires immediate attention please speak with the health room. (asthma, allergies, diabetes, any others)
- Please let your teacher know if your child requires a peanut free table at lunch.
- If your child will need medications to be given while at school, a order is needed from a medical provider dated after July 1st. Medical order forms are available on our website or in the health room.

Telemedicine

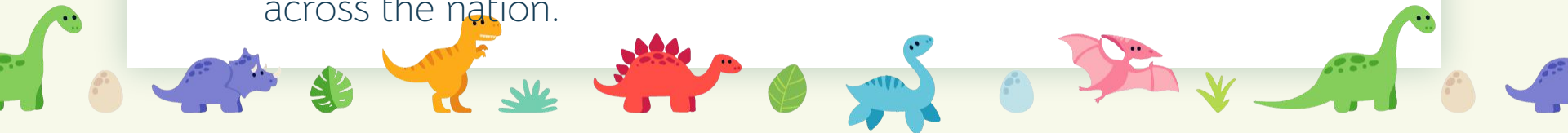
- A visit with medical provider through the computer while the child remains in the nurse's office.
- Conditions they can treat: Earache, sore throat (strep test), asthma, itching/rash, headache, etc.
- Medications they can send an order for: Ibuprofen, acetaminophen, hydrocortisone, albuterol
- MUST have signed consent (can do in the nurse's office tonight or tomorrow) PLUS day of verbal consent
- If "not contagious," may return to class

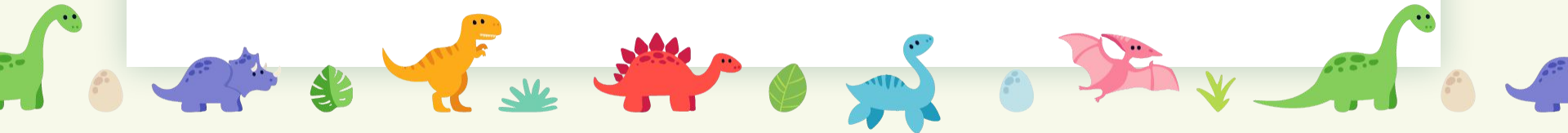
